### Internship

As a practical part of B.Ed. courses, school placement internships are completed in two phases Phase I and Phase II Phase I is of one week Phase II is of 11 weeks in which the students go to the actual school for classes V to IX. Teaching work has to be done and in that way it is necessary to select the selected component and remove the heel of the selected component. On that heel, the guide goes to that school with the signature of the subject expert and takes the class at the right place at the right time. It is evaluated in the observation book. The teacher conducts and all the other observations are done by the professor, which helps the B.Ed. trainees to get hands-on knowledge of how to approach the subject they teach in school.
